

Rolex Dancers First Award Winners: Piotr Stanczyk and Hannah Fischer

September 19, 2016... **Karen Kain**, Artistic Director of The National Ballet of Canada announced today that Principal Dancer **Piotr Stanczyk** and Second Soloist **Hannah Fischer** are the recipients of the Rolex *Dancers First* Award. Ms. Kain and **Victor Royce**, President and CEO of Rolex Canada Ltd. presented the award at a dinner and presentation in Toronto last night.

The Rolex *Dancers First* Award recognizes outstanding performances in the previous season and is juried by a committee of members of the National Ballet's Artistic Staff. Ms. Fischer and Mr. Stanczyk are recognized for their portrayals of Hermione and Leontes in *The Winter's Tale*. Both were awarded \$3,000 and a work by glass artist Elizabeth Beecham of Glasstronomy Studios.
